The Filterra® standard sized box accommodates a 2 foot root zone. Larger trees will require deeper boxes. Modified custom boxes can be manufactured at an additional cost.

The species listed are drought tolerant and have applicability to bioretention due to shallow root zones.

Each Filterra® unit must receive adequate irrigation to ensure survival of the living system during periods of drier weather. This may be achieved through a piped system, gutter flow or through the tree grate. In common with all plants, each Filterra plant will require more frequent watering during the establishment period
